

**WESTMORELAND COUNTY 2014 HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN
MUNICIPAL RESOLUTION #2-2015
FAIRFIELD TOWNSHIP OF WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

WHEREAS, the Township of Fairfield, Westmoreland County, Pennsylvania is most vulnerable to natural and human-made hazards which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, the Township of Fairfield acknowledges the requirements of Section 322 DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

WHEREAS, the Westmoreland County 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by the Westmoreland County Department of Public Safety and the Westmoreland County Planning Department in cooperation with other county departments, and officials of Fairfield Township, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consist with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Westmoreland County 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan, and


WHEREAS, the Westmoreland County 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body for the Township of Fairfield Township:




- The Westmoreland County 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Township of Fairfield, and
